Indicator:

### External resources for health as % of general government expenditure on health, 2000

**Definition:** External Resources are loans and grants for medical care and medical goods channelled through the Ministry of Health or other public agencies. Grants in-kind (capital equipment, pharmaceutical supplies and vaccines, technical assistance such as experts) should be estimated at their monetary values. Grants to non-governmental organisations should be accounted for as private (in practice, this is difficult).
