Definition: Private Expenditure on Health (PvtHE) comprises the outlays of insurers and third-party payers other than social security, mandated employer health services and other enterprise provided health services, non-profit institutions and non-governmental organisations financed health care, private investments in medical care facilities and household out-of-pocket spending.
